【Directions】

From Kapalua West Maui Airport / JHM (approximately 4 miles):

Turn left. Take Honoapi'ilani Highway (Hwy 30) to fourth traffic signal. Turn right on Ka'anapali Parkway. Proceed to Nohea Kai Drive and turn left. Drive ends at entrance of hotel.

1) **Rental Car:**

Budget, or Dollar Rent-A-Car are available nearby the terminal. Enterprise is located at the Sheraton, and Hertz is located at Hyatt Regency Maui, as well on Honoapiilani Highway in Lahaina

2) **Taxi:**

Service is available outside baggage claim area.

-Cost: Approximately \$20.00 one way. The ride should take about 10 minutes

3) **Executive Shuttle:**

Families of 8 and more should call for rates. Group rates are available upon request.

-Cost: Approximately \$10.00 for one person, \$13.00 for two people, \$15.00 for three people, \$17.00 for four people, \$19 for five people, \$21 for six people and \$23 for 7 people.

An additional \$5.00 charge is assessed if guest will be paying by credit card.

From Kahului Airport / OGG (approximately 27 miles):

Take Highway 380 to Highway 30. Take Honoapi'ilani Highway through Lahaina to the entrance of Ka'anapali. Turn left onto Ka'anapali Parkway (traffic signal). Proceed to Nohea Kai Drive and turn left. Hotel is at end of the drive.

1) **Speedy Airport Shuttle:**

Reservations to our Maui airport hotel should be booked 48 hours in advance.

-Cost: Approximately \$45.00 for one person, with \$6.00 - \$10.00 increments for each additional family member.

-Cost: Approximately \$45.00 for one person, \$52.00 for two people, \$55.00 for three people, \$57.00 for four people, \$60 for five people, \$66 for six people and \$84 for 7 people. An additional \$5.00 charge is assessed if guest will be paying by credit card.

3) **Taxi:**

Service is available in the baggage claim area.

-Cost: Approximately \$88.00 (up to four people with luggage)

4) **Rental Car:**

Avis, Hertz, and Budget rental desks are adjacent to baggage claim.

These offices remain open until the last flight arrives.

-General Information-

【Weather】

There are generally two seasons in Maui. Winter (November through April), when temperatures typically range in the low-70s to mid-80s, and summer when the high can run into the low-90s.

【Time】

Hawaii follows Hawaii Standard Time (GMT-10 hours), which is 5 hours behind Eastern Standard Time and 2 hours behind Pacific Standard Time. Hawaii does not observe Daylight Savings Time so add one extra hour to the time difference during this period (March through November).

【Currency】

Hawaii's currency is the US dollar. Traveler's checks aren't necessary since credit cards are widely accepted and ATM machines are plentiful.

【Language】

English is spoken throughout the islands, but Hawaiian is also an official language of the state of Hawaii.

【Central Maui Area】

• Iao Valley State Park



Towering emerald peaks guard the lush valley floor of Iao Valley State Park. Located in Central Maui just west of Wailuku, this peaceful 4,000-acre, 10-mile long park is home to one of Maui's most recognizable landmarks, the 1,200-foot Iao Needle. This iconic green-mantled rock outcropping overlooks Iao stream and is an ideal attraction for easy hiking and sightseeing.

【West Maui Area】

• Kaanapali Beach



With three miles of white sand and crystal clear water, it's no wonder why Kaanapali Beach was once named America's Best Beach. Kaanapali was Hawaii's first planned resort and has become a model for resorts around the globe. One of Kaanapali Beach's most famous attractions is the daily cliff diving ceremony off of the beach's northernmost cliffs known as Puu Kekaa, or Black Rock.

• Lahaina



Lahaina is a historic town that has been transformed into a Maui hot spot with dozens of art galleries and a variety of unique shops and restaurants. Lahaina's sunny climate and oceanfront setting also provides the perfect backdrop for a variety of activities and entertainment.

【South Maui Area】

•Molokini



Molokini is a small, crescent moon-shaped island that is a State Marine Life and Bird Conservation District. Tours are available from nearby Maalaea Harbor and Lahaina. Early morning is the best time of day to explore this pristine reserve, and whale watching is an added bonus during the winter months. If you're a scuba or snorkeling enthusiast, a visit to Molokini is a Maui must.

【Upcountry Maui Area】

•Haleakala National Park



Haleakala National Park is home to Maui's highest peak. Rising 10,023 feet above sea level, Haleakala's graceful slopes can be seen from just about any point on the island. Haleakala means "house of the sun" in Hawaiian, and legend has it that the demigod Maui lassoed the sun from its journey across the sky as he stood on the volcano's summit, slowing its descent to make the day last even longer.

•Kula



Located in the central part of the island, Kula is also at the center of its culinary resurgence, with much of the exotic produce served at Maui's best Hawaii Regional Cuisine restaurants grown right here in the rich, volcanic soil. The fertile fields of Kula are an ideal place to stir up your appetite by taking a farm tour. Pick a Maui onion at Oo Farm, smell the sweet lavender and marvel at the stunning views at the Alii Kula Lavender Farm or see the protea at the Shim Coffee and Protea Farm Tour.

【East Maui Area】

•Hana



Along Maui's rugged eastern coastline is the peaceful town of Hana, considered one of the last unspoiled Hawaiian frontiers. The Hana Highway (HI-360) has 600 curves and 54 bridges. The road leads you through flourishing rainforests, flowing waterfalls, plunging pools and dramatic seascapes. There are plenty of opportunities to stop and enjoy the lovely views, so get an early start and take your time on your drive.
